
09 Mounting Options

Standard mounting options are shown below. Other mounting options are available.




Double Faced Tape

1/16" pressure sensitive foam tape. Best used in conjunction with silicone adhesive.



Z-Clip Mounting


2 inch mechanically mounted to wall and sign.



Velcro Hook (Loop)

For fabric surfaces such as office workstations.

Always test first.



Screw Holes - Torx


3/16" screw holes with optional 1.5" vandal resistant button torx.

Wall Anchors optional




Partition Hook

Custom acrylic hooks available in black, white, or clear for any size partition.



Magnetic Tape (Foil)

1/32" magnetic tape for steel surfaces or removable panels.




Wall or Ceiling Bracket







11 Changeable Message

Window slot signs offer the advantage of quick in-house changes. Simply print out a new name or message on paper and insert it into the clear window opening. Any number of slots can be fabricated. Custom sizes and layouts are available.

ADA restroom signs require raised characters and Braille. The ISA symbol (wheelchair) should be added to the sign if the restroom is wheelchair accessible. Custom sizes, colors, and layouts are available.



13 California Restrooms


California requires a separate geometric door sign. The sign color needs to contrast with the door color. Single user restrooms are required to be identified as gender neutral.







17 ADA Floor Plan



19 Sign Regulations

Laws regarding signage can exist on the national, state, or local level. The chart below helps illustrate this point. It is important to be aware that your particular state or local codes may vary or supercede federal ADA laws.

Federal ADA

The Federal ADA law, for the most part, covers signs that identify, direct,

or provide information regarding a particular room, area, or space.













State Regulations

Some states, such as California and New York,
have additional laws or regulations that
may vary or supercede federal requirements.











Local Level

Other sign types are governed at the local level (often by the fire marshal or building department) and can vary from area to area.












20 Size and Spacing

The proper spacing and size of different elements of an ADA sign is vital when someone is trying to read the sign visually or by touch. Characters, graphics, or Braille that are too close together or are too small make it hard to read or understand.



21 Character Height

Use this chart to determine the required character size of your ADA sign based on the mounting height of the sign and the likely viewing distance. The minimum character height will be indicated in the corresponding box below
